- Company grew in large part due to the acquisitions of and mergers with competing learning management systems.
- Acquired the competitor MadDuck in 2000, CampusWide Access Solutions Inc. from AT&T in 2001, and CEI SpecialTeams from iCollege Inc in 2001 in addition to the Cornell and George Washington system purchases.
- In 2005, purchased WebCT for \$180 million.
- In 2009, purchased Angel Learning for \$80 million and \$15 million in stock.

- Two consultants founded Blackboard to provide technical standards for online learning applications as part of the National Learning Infrastructure Initiative of Educause
